




OPERATION/MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Power / Balance System ™
Remote Control Dampers

Operation & Maintenance Instructions

All components recieved must be checked against packing slip within one week after receipt of goods

- Verify that the damper is completely in the open position when connected to the ductwork. (Do not force blade to open/close. To properly adjust, connect battery pack to termination near damper motor plate and actuate switch UP or DOWN accordingly.)
- 2. Secure PLENUM cable through wire tie and tighten accordingly (see Fig. 1-A) Plug RJ-11 end into termination point on damper motor plate.
- 3. Check that PVC motor cover is installed. Please consult factory if missing or damaged.
- 4. Replace battery in hand held battery pack as necessary.
- 5. Keep damper motor away from any direct contact of moisture or debris.
- 6. Do not lubricate any components of the Power/Balance System. All Nylon 6/6 bushings are permanently lubricated. Clean damper and components with compressed air only.
- 7. Any cable not purchased from United Enertech will void warranty of the damper and all related components.
- 8. Power/Balance motor does not require any scheduled maintenance over lifetime of damper.
